Pope St. John Paul II had a strong devotion to the Blessed Mother. During his time as pontiff, he added the Luminous Mysteries to the Rosary. The Proclamation of the Kingdom: Jesus talks about putting God first in our lives.





















The Transfiguration: Jesus takes Peter, James, and John up on a mountain. He talks with Moses and Elijah. He is shining.





















The Giving of the Eucharist: Jesus gives us His Body and Blood for the first time at the Last Supper.
